1. Call Regular Parks and Recreation Board meeting to order and establish a quorum is present.

President Nunez called the meeting to order at 6:50 p.m. and announced a quorum was present.

2. Welcome Guests.

President Nunez welcomed Chief Ashe, Wade Phelps, and Joe Hernandez to the meeting.

3. Citizen comments.

No citizens present.

4. Discussion and approval of regular minutes for April 20, 2021.

Motion: Gerardo Salas moved to approve the April 20, 2021 minutes as presented. Alicia Sandoval seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Discussion regarding movie in the park on July 2, 2021. (Presenter: Police Chief Ashe)

Chief Ashe addressed the Board to provide an update for movie in the park event for July 2, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. Chief Ashe informed the Board there will be a DJ, food trucks, and the movie will start about 8:45 p.m. and staff will be handing out popcorn.

President Nunez inquired about the emergency protocol for the park. Chief Ashe explained the protocol would be to call the Police Department. Chief Ashe stated Joe Gulley closing time is 10:00 p.m. unless a tournament event and Escondido closing time is dusk to dawn.

6. Discussion and possible action with update on the walking trail at St. Mary's Park and potential impact on Horn Toads. (Presenter: Dr. Wade Phelps)

Dr. Wade Phelps addressed the Board to discuss the horned toads. The horned toads are still at St. Mary's Park. The improvement to the walking trail should not affect the horned toads.

Parks & Streets Director Joe Hernandez addressed the board to discuss the walking trail. The improvement to the walking trail is to remove two inches of top soil and have decomposing granite installed.

President Nunez stated the City has three benches and six tables that could be utilized at St. Mary's Park. These items would need to be anchored down and chained. Parks & Streets Director Hernandez inquired if the Board was wanting cement blocks. President Nunez stated the cement blocks were not being considered at this time only the anchors and chains. President Nunez will discuss the anchors and chains with the City Manager William Linn.

Motion: Lucille Matthew moved to have Parks & Streets Director Hernandez move forward on the walking trail improvements at St. Mary's Park with a base of decomposing granite. Gerardo Salas seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
